- "Your magic is evil; we don't want you here" tweeted one of the palace guards


Elsa was heartbroken by the bullying she received online. How could people be so cruel?

My Responsibility

- I, _____, will be responsible when using my devices and while I'm. I promise to abide by the following rules:
- 1. I will not give out personal information such as my address, telephone number, parents' work address/telephone number, or the name and location of my school without my parents' permission.
- 2. I will tell my parents right away if I come across any information that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- 3. I will never agree to get together with someone I "meet" online without first checking with my parents. If my parents agree to the meeting, I will be sure that it is in a public place and bring my mother or father along.
- 4. I will go online or play video games when my parents say it's OK and limit my online time so that it doesn't interfere with chores, homework or other activities.
- 5. I will not respond to any messages that are mean or in any way make me feel uncomfortable. It is not my fault if I get a message like that. If I do I will tell my parents right away.
- 6. I will talk with my parents so that we can set up rules for going online. We will decide upon the time of day that I can be online, the length of time I can be online, and appropriate areas for me to visit. I will not access other areas or break these rules without their permission.
- 7. I will not give out my Internet password to anyone (even my best friends) other than my parents.
- 8. I will check with my parents before downloading or installing software or apps or doing anything that could possibly hurt our devices or jeopardise my family's privacy.
- 9.1 will be a good online citizen and not do anything that hurts other people or is against the law.
- 10.I will help my parents understand how to have fun and learn things online and teach them things about the Internet, computers and other technology.




LEARN THOSE STREET

Definitions:


- **CATFISHING:** In the online world, catfishing refers to the practice of setting up a fictitious online profile, most often for the purpose of luring another into a fraudulent romantic relationship.
- **CYBERBULLYING:** the use of electronic communication (texts, phone calls, social media posts) to bully a person, typically by sending messages of an intimidating or threatening nature.
- **CYBERSTALKING:** Repeatedly sending message that include threats of harm or are highly intimidating; engaging in other online activities that make a person afraid for his or her safety.
- **DENIGRATION:** "Dissing" someone online. Sending or posting cruel gossip or rumours about a person to damage his or her reputation or friendships.
- **EXCLUSION:** Intentionally excluding someone from an online group, like a "buddy list" or a game.
- FLAMING: Online fights using electronic messages with angry and vulgar language.
- FRIEND: a person with whom one has a bond of mutual affection,
- HARASSMENT: Repeatedly sending offensive, rude and insulting messages.
- IMPERSONATION: Breaking into someone's account, posing as that person and sending messages to make the person look bad, get that person in trouble or danger, or damage that person's reputation or friendships.
- OUTING: Sharing someone's secrets or embarrassing information online. Tricking someone
- PERMANENT POSTS: Most information communicated electronically is permanent and public, if not reported and removed. A negative online reputation, including for those who bully, can impact college admissions, employment, and other areas of life.
- TROLLING: Intentionally posting provocative messages about sensitive subjects to create conflict, upset people, and bait them into "flaming" or fighting.
- TRUSTED ADULT: is someone that you have a good relationship with. It is someone who you think has your best interests in mind. You have a right to choose whether you want a trusted adult and who that person will be.


